

## Post 184 Meeting Minutes, June 21, 2006

- 7:30pm – Commander Kirby called meeting to order, Chaplin Andriuk opened meeting with prayer.
- Previous meetings minutes were read by Adjutant and approved.
- Introduce Guests & New Members:
  - District 17 Officers for Change of Command ceremony – Cmdr Linden Dixon and Cmdr elect John Kokernak.
  - Ladies Auxiliary members and friends/relatives of Incoming Officers.
- Committee reports:
  - Finance - \$13,486.48 in checking and \$9,000+ in building fund CDs.
  - Finance spreadsheet posted on board.
- Avenue of Flags: No Veterans buried at Chestnut Grove in May 2006.
- Report on Memorial Day weekend events
  - 430 grave flags used at Chestnut Grove
    - Requested list of names from the Town of everyone buried in cemetery so we can update the master lists & plans with all Veterans.
  - 18 grave flags used at Oak Grove.
  - 36 casket flags flown on Avenue of Flags.
    - Total of 4 usable pole holes left. Total of 50 poles available in shed. Need work detail this summer to install at least 10 more holes.
  - 68 of 150 ceremony programs left over. Recommend printing 100 next year.
  - 107 Poppy's passed out at ceremony, should be close to attendance number.
  - VC Thompson attended JrNROTC Change of Command and awards ceremony and presented Post's medals. He reported being impressed with the precision of the units and the military professionalism of all involved.
- Flag Disposal: 3 1/2 boxes on hand
- Sno Cone & Poppy reports:
  - Poppy campaign detailed report sheet on board, total gross = \$10,553, with Jim Loftus having high single shift with \$818, second year in a row Jim has had high shift. Net of \$9,056.70 available for donations. 875 poppies left over for next year. Signed up 2 new members.
  - Sno Cone sales netted \$2,042. Signed up 1 new member.
- Review mailbag:
  - Awards, citations, resolutions, newsletters, etc.
- Review District Calendar/business:
  - Boy's State is in process
- Adjutant's Report:
  - William Wright has taken over the Poppy Campaign and I owe him letters and forms.
- Membership – 2006 campaign results as of 6-14-06: 248 members, 101.2% of goal.

- Department of Virginia has 85 Posts (39.4% of 216 Posts) at 100%+.
- District 17 has 6 of 18 Posts at 100%+ for 2006 goals and 10 of 18 Posts with the same or more members than last year.
- New 184 members since last meeting: Marion Bonhomme-Knox, Vincent Miller, and Carlos Puertas Jr.
- 2007 campaign has begun. PUFL's have received their Cards and I have received 184's annual membership cards.
